## Qualification description

This qualification reflects the role of shopfitters who construct or renovate commercial premises such as retail or office environments. It includes skills and knowledge to work safely using tools and equipment and to apply information from plans and drawings to fabricate, assemble and fix shop fronts and install internal units and partitions.

Occupational titles may include:

- Shopfitter

State and territory jurisdictions may have different licensing, legislative, regulatory or certification requirements. Relevant state and territory regulatory authorities should be consulted to confirm those requirements.

This qualification is suitable for an Australian apprenticeship pathway.

## Entry requirements

## Packaging rules

To achieve this qualification, competency must be demonstrated in:

- 18 units of competency:
  - 12 core units
  - 6 electives
- a minimum of four units must be selected from Group A
- two units can be selected from any group, current training package or accredited course as long as they contribute to a valid, industry-supported vocational outcome and maintain the AQF level of this qualification.
